

Seating Arrangement in 305 Ives Hall

Raw capacity : 318 (no extras counted)

Examination effective capacity : **167** (-do-)

LEGEND

- Tables show top (plan) view of lecture halls, blackboard at the top of the table
- CNTR is the centre of the hall; all halls are symmetric about the central axis
- White cell is a seat in an odd row
- Grey cell is a seat in an even row
- Green cell is aisle (NO SEAT)
- Red cell is wall or obstruction (NO SEAT)
- Seats numbered consecutively starting from front right corner
- If number is labelled explicitly, then seat can be occupied, otherwise no
- RC is row capacity (allowed seats in the row)
- CC is cumulative capacity
- ex in Ives Hall denotes a makeshift seat which has been set up for the examination. They are more comfortable than regular seats and are not recommended to be used
- Ives Hall has perfect centreline symmetry. Schematic representation of seats is approximate
